The following is a list of motion court dates and times to be used as appropriate in connection with the scheduling of motions before **Judge Jeffery A. Deller** in the Pittsburgh Division of the court, for the four-month period commencing July through October 2008. The use of these dates for scheduling motions is outlined below and on our website at: www.pawb.uscourts.gov. The motions will be heard in the Courtroom stated below.

CHAPTER 13 CASES

Counsel for a moving party shall select one of the following dates and times, insert same on the notice of hearing for the motion, and serve the notice on all respondents, trustee and parties in interest. In addition, those attorneys or law firms who represent the moving party and are identified below may use any hearing date **on the list** but shall use only the time assigned for hearings unless (a) special arrangements have been approved in advance by the Court or the Chapter 13 Clerk or (b) another motion in the same bankruptcy case has already been set for hearing at a different time and the moving party chooses to use the same date and time as the previously set matter. Where a particular type of motion is listed by the time, all attorneys and law firms shall utilize that time for the motions indicated unless (a) special arrangements have been approved in advance by the Court or the Chapter 13 Clerk or (b) another motion in the same bankruptcy case has already been set for hearing at a different time and the moving party chooses to use the same date and time as the previously set matter.
