TEMPORARY CHANGE IN CASE NUMBERING SYSTEM**

Please be advised that the Bankruptcy Case Numbering System will be modified for cases filed from October 17, 2005, through December 31, 2005. The modification will help in identifying cases filed under the provisions of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005.

Bankruptcy case numbers will continue to be comprised of a 2-digit year, followed by a consecutively assigned 5-digit case number, followed by the initials of the appointed Judge. However, the numbering series in the 5-digit case number will change during the interim period as follows:

<b>Filing Location</b>	<b>Interim Case Numbering Series</b>
Pittsburgh County Cases	50000 Series (First Case No. will be 05-50001-xxx)
Johnstown County Cases	80000 Series (First Case No. will be 05-80001-xxx)
Erie Division Cases	90000 Series (First Case No. will be 05-90001-xxx)

On January 1, 2006, case numbering will resume to the normal numbering as follows:

<b>Filing Location</b>	<b>Normal Case Numbering Series</b>
Pittsburgh County Cases	20000 Series, followed by 30000 Series, followed by 40000 Series, (First Case No. will be 06-20001-xxx)
Johnstown County Cases	70000 Series (First Case No. will be 06-70001-xxx)
Erie Division Cases	10000 Series (First Case No. will be 06-10001-xxx)
