Professional persons or entities performing services in the above case are advised that approval of fees for professional services will be based not only on the amount involved and the results accomplished, but other factors as well including: the time and labor reasonably required by the applicant to perform, the novelty and difficulty of the issues presented, the skill requisite to perform the service properly, the preclusion of other employment due to acceptance of this case, the customary fee for similar services, the time limitations imposed by the client or the circumstances encountered while performing the services, the experience, reputation and ability of the professional(s) involved, the undesirability of the case, the nature and length of the professional relationship with the client, and, awards in similar cases.
4. Approval of any application for appointment of a professional in which certain fees are requested for various identified professionals is not an agreement by the Court to allow such fees at the requested hourly rates. Final compensation, awarded only after notice and hearing, may be more or less than the requested hourly rates based on application of the above-mentioned factors in granting approval by Court Order.
5. ***Applicant shall serve the within Order on all interested parties and file a certificate of service.***
