RULE 12

MAILING MATRIX

The Debtor shall file, simultaneously with the lists of creditors required to be filed on his schedules, a mailing matrix containing the name, address and zip code of the Debtor, the Debtor's Attorney and, in alphabetical order, the names, addresses and zip codes of all creditors listed on the schedules; for Chapter 11 cases, a separate matrix shall be filed listing the ten largest unsecured creditors.

RULE 13

QUARTERLY REPORT OF TRUSTEE'S DEPOSITS

Each trustee who makes deposits of estate funds pursuant to authority granted him by 11 U.S.C. §345 shall file a quarterly report with the Clerk of Court within ten days after March 31, June 30, September 30 and December 31, providing for each Bankruptcy Case the name of the financial institution where such deposits have been made, the amount on deposit, and any interest which has accrued as of the date of the report.
