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ORDER AMENDING LOCAL RULE

AND NOW, this 28th day of October, 1981,
Local Rule 6(c) is hereby amended by including panel member trustees among those individuals who may temporarily remove, at the Clerk's discretion, records or papers belonging to the files of the court.

With the addition underlined Rule 6(c) reads as follows:

Withdrawal of Files. Records and papers on file in the Office of the Clerk of Court may be produced pursuant to a subpoena from any Federal or State Court, directing their production. At the Clerk's discretion, records or papers belonging to the files of the court may be temporarily removed by the United States Attorney, District Judges, Magistrates, and panel member trustees of this District upon receipt of a signed requisition. Otherwise, records and papers may be removed from the files only upon order of the Court. Whenever records or papers are withdrawn, the person receiving them shall leave with the Clerk a signed receipt describing the records or papers taken.
