CHAPTER 13  
PROCEEDURAL ORDER #2

AND NOW, to-wit, this 6th day of <sup>Nov</sup>~~November~~ 1982, it is hereby ORDERED that Chapter 13 debtors shall be required to pay to the Trustee the amount of the proposed plan payment on or before the First Meeting of Creditors; and other payments shall be required every 30 days after that until an Order of Confirmation or Modification is entered by this Court.

Failure to comply with this order shall be proof of bad faith. After notice and a hearing and upon motion of the Trustee the Court shall enter a conversion to a chapter 7; dismiss the case; or enter other appropriate relief as dictated by the best interests of the Creditors.

A copy of this Order shall be given to the debtor(s) or counsel when the case is filed.

This Order shall be effective January 1, 1983. The Chapter 13 Trustees shall place notice of this Order with the Bar Association and the Pittsburgh Legal Journal twenty (20) and ten (10) days before its effective date.
