ORDER DIRECTING STANDING CHAPTER 13 TRUSTEES
TO PAY FUNDS INTO ESCROW


WHEREAS, it appears the Pittsburgh Division chapter 13 standing trustees may be holding chapter 13 funds not needed to pay any creditor, debtor, or administrative claimant:

The trustees, Donald R. Calaiaro and Ralph J. Saldamarco, are hereby **ORDERED AND DIRECTED** to pay to the clerk, Theodore S. Hopkins, the sums of \$27,422.88 and \$19,204.85, respectively, within the next ten days. The clerk shall forthwith deposit said sums in a registry fund account to be held in escrow until further order of court.
