## ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this \_\_\_\_\_ day of September, 1985, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a duplicate copy of all Bankruptcy Petitions, all Adversary Complaints, and all other pleadings be filed in all cases in the Erie Division which are assigned to a Judge in the Pittsburgh Division.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if a duplicate copy of the Bankruptcy Petition and Adversary Complaint is not presented at the time of filing, the filing party shall have five (5) days in which to file the duplicate copy.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that after the Bankruptcy Petition or Adversary Complaint is filed, the Clerk shall not accept any other pleading in a case assigned to a Judge in the Pittsburgh Division without a duplicate copy.
