



ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 8 day of April, 1986, effective immediately, the Clerk shall assign all Pittsburgh Division chapter 13 cases equally between Judge Joseph L. Cosetti and Judge Bernard Markovitz, except that any chapter 13 case which normally would be heard in Johnstown shall be assigned to Judge Markovitz. As to such Johnstown cases, there shall be given a credit to Judge Markovitz so that for each credit, Judge Cosetti will be assigned the next chapter 13 case assigned to Judge Markovitz which is normally heard in Pittsburgh until all credits have been used.

The Clerk is further directed to assign to Judge Bentz chapter 7 cases in lieu of the Pittsburgh Division chapter 13 cases he would otherwise have been assigned in a ratio of 1.5 chapter 7 cases for each chapter 13 case. This ratio will be prospectively applied on a quarterly basis to chapter 7 cases normally heard in Pittsburgh to be drawn equally from cases assigned to both Judge Markovitz and Judge Cosetti.
