ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this **2nd** day of **August, 1991**, **IT IS ORDERED** that General Order #86-3 and General Order #89-5, requiring the trustee in asset Chapter 7 cases to file zero balance statements and cancelled checks, are rescinded. No panel member trustee, except as otherwise ordered, shall be required to file zero balance statements and cancelled checks with the court in view of the procedure established by the U.S. Trustee's Office in this District requiring such documents be filed with that office. However, all non-panel member trustees appointed in asset Chapter 7 cases shall continue to file zero balance statements and cancelled checks with the court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the U.S. Trustee's Office file within 150 days of the entry of an order of distribution the "U.S. Trustee's Statement of Review" which acknowledges that the U.S. Trustee has reviewed and has no objection to the Chapter 7 trustee's Certification of Completion of Estate Administration and Application for Discharge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the trustee, appointed in any asset Chapter 7 case, shall file with the Court the "Report For Bankruptcy Judges In Cases To Be Closed".
