## **ORDER**

Whereas a need exists to adequately identify Matters presented to the Court which are proposed to be filed under seal and also preserve the in camera status of the documents being filed,

**NOW Therefore**, this 19<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1999, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in all instances where Counsel files a Motion to seal a document or has otherwise obtained approval from the Court to file a sealed document, the document shall be presented at the Clerk's office in a sealed envelope. Affixed to the outside of the envelope shall be a statement containing a case caption and case number and which identifies the contents for the purpose of tracking. The statement must contain sufficient particularity regarding the nature of the document proposed to be placed under seal without disclosing the specifics of the enclosed Matter.

This Order shall become effective May 19<sup>th</sup>, 1999.
