ORDER

WHEREAS Rule 3003(c)(3) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure provides that the Court shall fix the time within which proofs of claim may be filed in Chapter 11 cases, and

WHEREAS the Court deems that 90 days from the §341 Meeting of Creditors is a reasonable period of time;

NOW THEREFORE, this 21st day of September, 2007, the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to provide in all Chapter 11 §341 Notices a deadline date which is 90 days after the first date set for the meeting of creditors within which proofs of claim may be filed. This period, which shall be computer generated and inserted in the §341 Meeting of Creditors Notices, shall constitute the fixing by the Court of the claims bar date as required by FRBP 3003(c)(3).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that General Order #97-1 is abrogated.
