**Exemption of PACER Fees
for a One-Year Period**

ORDER

WHEREAS Massachusetts Institute of Technology Department of Economics and MIT-Sloan School of Management doctoral candidates Jialan Wang, Tal Gross, and Matthew Notowidigdo have requested an exemption from Electronic Public Access fees for academic research; and

WHEREAS this Court finds that an exemption is necessary to avoid unnecessary burdens and to promote public access to information,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, this 25th day of February 2009, that the request is granted. A waiver of PACER fees for accessing documents of record in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania shall be effected for the benefit of the MIT team of research economists comprised of Jialan Wang, Tal Gross, and Matthew Notowidigdo. The exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court during this one-year period. In compliance with the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States, Jialan Wang, Tal Gross, and Matthew Notowidigdo shall not sell the data obtained by use of this exemption.

The Clerk shall give appropriate Notice of this Order.
