**Exemption of PACER Fees
for a One-Year Period**

ORDER

WHEREAS Elizabeth Warren, Professor of Law at Harvard Law School, has requested an exemption from the Electronic Public Access fee schedule for academic research; and

WHEREAS this Court finds that an exemption is necessary to avoid unnecessary burdens and to promote public access to information.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, this 10th day of November, 2009, that the request is granted. A waiver of PACER fees for accessing documents of record in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania shall be effected for the benefit of the Elizabeth Warren, Professor of Law at Harvard Law School. The exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court during this one-year period. In compliance with the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States, Professor Elizabeth Warren shall not sell the data obtained by use of this exemption.

The Clerk shall give appropriate Notice of this Order.
