WHEREAS Lois R. Lupica, Professor of Law at University of Maine Law School, has requested an exemption from the Electronic Public Access fee schedule for academic research; and

WHEREAS this Court finds that an exemption is necessary to avoid unnecessary burdens and to promote public access to information.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, this 23rd day of March 2010 that the request is granted. A waiver of PACER fees for accessing documents of record in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania shall be effected for the benefit of Lois R. Lupica, Professor of Law at University of Maine Law School. The exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court during this one-year period. In compliance with the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States, Professor Lois R. Lupica shall not sell the data obtained by use of this exemption.
