

Neighborhood Legal Services Association offers a free Do-It-Yourself Bankruptcy Clinic to help eligible low-income individuals file Chapter 7 bankruptcy on their own without hiring a lawyer.

To participate in the clinic you must be financially eligible for NLSA and must have bankruptcy issues that fall within the limited scope of the DIY clinic. Eligibility is determined by NLSA.

Participants will use online software called Upsolve to complete the bankruptcy forms. The DIY clinic provides information about filing bankruptcy and advice from volunteer lawyers who will review the documents and answer basic questions about bankruptcy.

The DIY clinic lawyers will not prepare the paperwork nor go to court on behalf of anyone who attends the clinic.
