INFORMATION REGARDING STANDING ORDERS 20-207, 20-208 AND 20-209

Due to the COVID-19 situation, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania has determined that it is in the interest of the health and safety of the public and Court personnel to implement the following Standing Orders:

Standing Order 20-207 requires Declarations of Electronic filing (Local Forms 1A and 1B) to be submitted through the Court's electronic document submission system ("EDSS").

Standing Order 20-208 requires all claims to be filed electronically in the CM/ECF System or by using the ePOC System. Pro Se creditors without access to a computer may continue to file claims through the mail.
