## **STANDING ORDER**

The United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania approved the revised Local Bankruptcy Rules on September 22, 2021.

AND NOW, this 29th day of September, 2021, it is hereby ORDERED that:

- (1) The revised Local Bankruptcy Rules are adopted by the Bankruptcy Court and shall be *effective* as of *November 1, 2021*.
- (2) The following Standing Orders are hereby superseded:

- (3) The following Standing Orders shall remain in full force and effect until further order of Court:

  - (c) Standing Order 20-220 (amending W.PA.LBR 3011-1),

  - (e) Standing Order 21-201 (amending W.PA.LBR 5005-20), and
  - (f) Standing Order 21-204 (amending W.PA.LBR 9020-7).
