(2) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the letter of engagement or agreement between Movant and the Auctioneer, this *Order* does not authorize the Auctioneer to retain or pay any outside counsel or other professional to assist the Auctioneer in this matter unless such is done at no expense to Movant, directly or indirectly. Any other retention of and payment to an outside counsel or other professional is subject to prior approval of the Court.
