IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if a duplicate copy of the Bankruptcy Petition and Adversary Complaint is not presented at the time of filing, the filing party shall have five (5) days in which to file the duplicate copy.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that after the Bankruptcy Petition or Adversary Complaint is filed, the Clerk shall not accept any other pleading in a case assigned to Judge Bentz without a duplicate copy.
