Whereas, a continuing need exists to provide for an orderly assignment of cases filed in this District,			
NOW THEREFORE, this <u>31st</u> day of <u>March</u> , 2010, this Order regarding the assignment of cases shall supersede and replace General Order #2009-6 dated September 15, 2009. This Order is effective as of and retroactive to March 22, 2010.			
(1) The Pittsburgh Division of the Court is comprised of the Johnstown Counties and the Pittsburgh Counties. The counties of Bedford, Blair, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset and Clearfield constitute the Johnstown Counties. The counties of Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Butler, Fayette, Greene, Lawrence, Washington and Westmoreland constitute the Pittsburgh Counties. The Erie Division is comprised of the counties of Erie, Clarion, Elk, Jefferson, McKean, Warren, Crawford, Forest, Mercer, and Venango.			
(2) All cases filed in the Erie Division of the Court shall be assigned to Judge Agresti.			
(3) All cases filed in the Johnstown Counties shall be assigned to Judge Deller.			
(4) The Clerk shall maintain a case assignment system that provides a distribution of bankruptcy cases as specified in this order. Cases filed in the Pittsburgh Division of the court will			
be promptly assigned on a random basis, except as otherwise noted, to all bankruptcy judges in the			

the Pittsburgh Counties.

Judge McCullough shall be assigned all Chapter 7 cases filed by debtors in

(b)	Judges Agresti, McCullough, Fitzgerald, and Deller shall be assigned an equa
	number of Chapter 11 cases filed by debtors in the Pittsburgh Counties with
	Judges Agresti and Deller given credit for Chapter 11 cases assigned to them
	in the Erie Division and Johnstown Counties.

- (c) Chapter 13 cases filed in the Pittsburgh Counties shall be assigned according to the following formula: Judge Fitzgerald will receive 58% of the cases; Judge Deller will receive 30% of the cases; and Judge Agresti will receive 12% of the cases.
- (d) Judges Fitzgerald and Deller shall be assigned an equal number of Chapter 12 cases in the Pittsburgh Counties.
- (e) Judges Fitzgerald, McCullough, and Deller will be assigned an equal number of Chapter 15 cases in the Pittsburgh Counties.
