COURT TO REMAIN OPEN DURING GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN

Despite the government shutdown, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania will remain open and continue operations pending further Order of the Court. Filings will continue to be accepted. Hearings and trials will proceed as scheduled. For those cases where the United States is a party or where the government is a party in interest represented by counsel affected by the shutdown, the presiding judge shall retain discretion to determine whether to proceed with such matters, grant a continuance, or take other action.
