## **STANDING ORDER**

The Pennsylvania Department of Health lifted the universal face covering requirement on June 28, 2021.

AND NOW THEREFORE, this  $6^{th}$  day of July, 2021, it is hereby ORDERED that, effective immediately:

- 1. All persons entering any facility of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania (the "Court") are permitted to wear a face mask or face covering if they so choose; however, individuals appearing before the Court may be required to remove their face mask or face covering at the discretion of the presiding Judge.
- 2. Persons entering the Court's Pittsburgh facility are no longer required to wear face masks or face coverings.
- 3. Persons entering the Court's Erie or Johnstown facilities shall comply with the applicable Administrative Order of the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania. See Misc. No. 2:20-mc-593-MRH.
  - 4. This Order supersedes Standing Order No. 20-211 in its entirety.
  - 5. This Order shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.
