STANDING ORDER

The Pennsylvania Department of Health lifted the universal face covering requirement on June 28, 2021.

AND NOW THEREFORE, this 6th day of ***July, 2021***, it is hereby ***ORDERED*** that, ***effective immediately***:

1. All persons entering any facility of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania (the “Court”) are permitted to wear a face mask or face covering if they so choose; however, individuals appearing before the Court may be required to remove their face mask or face covering at the discretion of the presiding Judge.
2. Persons entering the Court’s Pittsburgh facility are no longer required to wear face masks or face coverings.
3. Persons entering the Court’s Erie or Johnstown facilities shall comply with the applicable Administrative Order of the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania. See [Misc. No. 2:20-mc-593-MRH](#).
4. This Order supersedes Standing Order No. 20-211 in its entirety.
5. This Order shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.
