STANDING ORDER

The Judges of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania (the “Bankruptcy Court”) have determined that there is a need to revise the Local Bankruptcy Rules. The Judicial Council of the Third Circuit Court of Appeals approved the revised Local Bankruptcy Rules on August 4, 2021. The United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania approved the revised Local Bankruptcy Rules on September 22, 2021.

AND NOW, this *29th* day of *September, 2021*, it is hereby *ORDERED* that:

- (1) The revised Local Bankruptcy Rules are adopted by the Bankruptcy Court and shall be *effective* as of *November 1, 2021*.
- (2) The following Standing Orders are hereby superseded:
 - (a) Standing Order 17-205,
 - (b) Standing Order 17-215, and
 - (c) Standing Order 18-204.
- (3) The following Standing Orders shall remain in full force and effect until further order of Court:
 - (a) Standing Order 20-207 (suspending *W.P.A.LBR* 5005-7),
 - (b) Standing Order 20-208 (amending *W.P.A.LBR* 3002-1(f)),
 - (c) Standing Order 20-220 (amending *W.P.A.LBR* 3011-1),
 - (d) Standing Order 20-222 (amending *W.P.A.LBR* 2016-1(f)),
 - (e) Standing Order 21-201 (amending *W.P.A.LBR* 5005-20), and
 - (f) Standing Order 21-204 (amending *W.P.A.LBR* 9020-7).
