STANDING ORDER

In the event the United States Congress and the President do not enact an appropriation or continuing resolution that funds the operations of the United States Courts beyond September 30, 2025, this Standing Order shall govern the operations of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania (the "Bankruptcy Court") until such time as an appropriation bill or continuing resolution is passed, or an Order is issued that supersedes this Order. Dispensing justice is mandated by the Constitution and is essential to government.

AND NOW THEREFORE, this 30th day of September 2025, it is hereby ORDERED

- 1. The Bankruptcy Court shall remain open and maintain staffing consistent with the guidance provided by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts in order to ensure the continuation of the Court's ability to fulfill its constitutional functions.
- 2. The General Services Administration, Federal Protective Service, and U.S. Marshals Service are requested to maintain all functions necessary for the continued safe use of all Bankruptcy Court space.
